

It Matters

This past Sunday we began our study in 1 John. We noticed that John gives his readers at least four reasons why he wrote them: "We write this to make our joy complete." (1:4); "My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin." (2:1); "I am writing these things to you about those who are trying to lead you astray." (2:26); "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life." (5:13). All four of these are important principles for us today.

As we introduced the letter, we saw that John tells us what matters in terms of our fellowship with God and each other:

- Doctrine Matters Doctrine is simply what we believe and John tells us that what we believe matters. Not any and every teaching is acceptable.
- Holiness Matters We cannot have fellowship with God and live our lives contrary to His commands.
- Love Matters We cannot have fellowship with God if we do not love others.
- Confidence Matters John says that we can KNOW that we have eternal life. The Christian life should be one of certainty, not based on our own righteousness, but on our fellowship with God through His Son.

Hope to see you Sunday as we dive deeper into John's letter.
